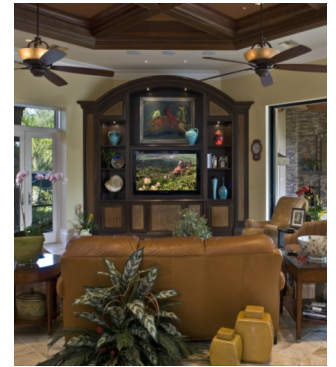

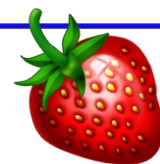

Someone's in the Kitchen: Old-fashioned Strawberry Jam



My friend Liz and I recently rediscovered this great recipe for strawberry jam, as enticing to the eye as it is to the taste... bright red color and oh-so-good! Find a farmer's market, a friend and make a couple of batches!

4 cups crushed, fresh strawberries

4 cups sugar

You'll need 4 half-pint canning jars, lids and bands. Sterilize the jars and bands by running them through the dishwasher at high heat. Keep lids in scalding hot water until ready to use.

Rinse, cap and crush strawberries into a 4 to 5 quart pot; stir in sugar until well blended. Bring to a boil over high heat, stirring constantly. Continue boiling, uncovered for 10 to 15 minutes or until thickened. You'll need to stir occasionally. Near end of cooking time, skim off foam.

Pour into hot jars to within 1/8" of the rim. Wipe off rim with clean towel. Place lids on jars and screw on ring bands as tightly as you comfortably can. Let cool on a towel, out of a draft. You'll hear the "pop" of the lids as they seal. Or you can press down on the lid—if it stays down, it is sealed. Label and store in cool, dark place. Makes a great gift!
